The final grade is determined with the following ranking: A, B, C, D, E, FX, F.</p> <p>A – Excellent 91-100 points;</p> <p>B – Very Good 81-90 points</p> <p>C – Good 71-80 points</p> <p>D– Satisfactory 61-70 points;</p> <p>E – Sufficient 51-60 points;</p> <p>FX – could not pass 41-50 points. Student has the right to take the additional exam once more;</p> <p>F – Fail 0-40 points. Student has to take the course again.</p>
