Program Volume in Credits	The Bachelor’s educational program of Law comprises 240 credits: compulsory components of non-legal profile – 60 ELTS, compulsory basics components of legal profile – 127 ECTS, compulsory courses concentrated in the elective direction of law – 53 ECTS.
Aim of the Educational Program	The advancement of the contemporary society becomes more and more dependent on law and justice. Owing to this, the demand for a qualified lawyer is increasing. The aim of the educational program is to provide high legal education applicable for the basic practice and theory, relevant to the first cycle of academic higher education. It implies the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • to teach basic issues of law, methods, and elaborate skills for their application; • To teach the basics of the worldwide legal systems as well as thorough study of international law, Georgian public, private and criminal law; • To master the methods of working on legal acts (reading, understanding, define hierarchy, application).
Learning Outcomes	The graduate will have broad knowledge of the basic peculiarities, principles and institutions of the national and worldwide legal systems, as well as thorough knowledge of international law, Georgian public, private and criminal law; skills of identification of legal problems, searching for normative acts for problem solution and their application; The graduate will be able to make up legal documents (normative act projects, agreements, suits, claims, etc.) according to the specific instructions; find information in native and foreign languages, process and deliver in oral or written form using legal terminology; The graduate will be inclined to promote implementation of individuals’ rights as well as act in accordance with justice, human rights, social and democratic values.
Assessment	Students are evaluated according to the following system: a) (A) – Excellent - 91 points and more; b) (B) – Very Good - 81-90 points; c) (C) – Good 71-80 points; d) (D)– Satisfactory 61-70 points; e) (E) – Sufficient 51-60 points; (FX) – could not pass 41-50 points. Student has the right to take the additional exam once more; (F) – Fail 0-40 points. Student has to take the course again.
