Aim of the Educational Program	To teach formation of legal values, means of accomplishing identification and analysis; deep and systemic knowledge in general and subject-specific principles, institutes, categories and legislation base of public and criminal law; to teach methods of obtaining and processing legal information; to teach psychological aspects of legal relations; development of necessary skills of independent identification and qualification of public and criminal problems.
Learning Outcomes	The graduate will have thorough and systemic knowledge of the basic concepts, institutes, conceptual approaches and mechanisms of public and criminal law; will also know the principles, theories and systems of international law of human rights that will enable to understand and perceive solution ways for specific legal problems in new unpredicted environments and elaborate new original ideas; the graduate will be able to act in multidisciplinary environment an search for new original ways for problem solution, communicate with academic or professional community in Georgian and foreign languages; the graduate will be able to design legal acts, regulations and other documents, set and study research problems; complex evaluation of the problems related to the directions of public and criminal law and elaborate original ways of solution considering strategic, future-oriented factors; complex processing, analysis and conclusion of information by means of innovative synthesis.
Assessment	Students are evaluated according to the following system: a) (A) – Excellent - 91 points and more; b) (B) – Very Good - 81-90 points; c) (C) – Good 71-80 points; d) (D)– Satisfactory 61-70 points; e) (E) – Sufficient 51-60 points; (FX) – could not pass 41-50 points. Student has the right to take the additional exam once more; (F) – Fail 0-40 points. Student has to take the course again.
