Aim of the Educational Program	<p>The aim of the program is to give students broad knowledge in the field of psychology. Students will understand peculiar nature of the study of psychic world that, primarily, provides unlimited opportunities to realize human creative potential within boundless space of human psyche, and in this sense, is beyond competition with other spheres of cognition.</p> <p>As the basis of humankind civilization, human psyche naturally connects any sphere of activities originated from the mental creativity – to psychology. Thus, mastering study courses in psychology gives real opportunities of employment to the graduates of the specialty of psychology.</p> <p>Psychological education acquired by students during the study period will be enough for the graduates to fulfil duties of improving relationships within the organizations of any types of activities or social structure, by interpreting of psychological processes, explanations under the high quality psychologists’ supervision; solve problems related to psychological assistance, support, consulting or intervention.</p>
Learning Outcomes	<p>Is able to understand, observe, interpret psychological states, facts, events, laws, regularities, mechanisms and problems; gather, accumulate, analyze and apply psychological information;</p> <p>Is able to participate with a group of specialists in diagnostics of psychic disorders, elaboration and implementation of intervention and consultation tactics.</p>
Assessment	<p>Credit accumulation is possible only after achieving learning results scheduled by syllabus that is expressed by one of the positive assessment grades implied by the multi-component evaluation system. The maximum assessment score of the academic program is 100 points. The evaluation system allows for five types of positive assessments;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) (A) Excellent – 91% and more of the maximum score; b) (B) Very Good - 81-90% of the maximum score; c) (C) Good - 71-80% of the maximum score; d) (D) Satisfactory - 61-70% of the maximum score; e) (E) Sufficient - 51-60% of the maximum score; <p>There are two types of negative assessments:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) (FX) Could not Pass - 41-50% of the maximum score meaning that student needs more time to pass and is given the right to take additional exam after independent work; b) (F) Fail - 40% and less of the maximum score meaning that the work conducted by a student is not sufficient and he/she has to pass the course again.
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
